## Wall and Floor Tilers in Australia



### Who are they?

Wall and floor tilers are experts in the meticulous art of installing clay, ceramic, marble, slate, and glass tiles on both indoor and outdoor surfaces, serving both functional and aesthetic purposes. This specialized trade has experienced significant growth in recent years and offers a rewarding career for individuals who derive satisfaction from hands-on work combined with a touch of creativity.

Wall and floor tilers, like other tradespeople, engage in a variety of manual tasks, relying on their practical skills to solve problems and effectively communicate with customers directly. This profession is ideal for individuals who prefer hands-on work that yields visible outcomes, as opposed to more desk-bound roles.

According to data provided by Job Outlook, a government initiative, this is one of the fields with most significant employment growth in the past, from 2013 to 2015, with a remarkable increase of over 68%. Forecasts indicate that the industry will continue to experience a gradual and steady increase in employment levels. Job openings are anticipated to remain at an average level, considering both growth and turnover factors.

### How to become one?

In terms of education and training, wall and floor tilers commonly acquire a Certificate III or IV qualification to enhance their knowledge and skills essential for success in the field. Many professionals in this industry choose to further their expertise by enrolling in additional courses, particularly if they decide to establish their own businesses.

Courses in tiling generally combine theoretical learning with a hands-on approach, allowing individuals to become acquainted with the practical aspects of the profession. This approach enables students to familiarize themselves with the working environment while developing essential critical thinking and communication skills vital for excelling in the industry.

In this trade, the ability to learn quickly while on the job, coupled with strong communication skills, is highly valued. Attention to detail is crucial, as tilers must ensure precise placement and alignment of tiles. Additionally, creative skills can be advantageous when working with decorative or mosaic tiles, allowing for the creation of visually striking and aesthetically pleasing designs. Those possessing these qualities will be viewed favorably within the wall and floor tiling industry.

### Extension of Post-study Work Visa

In late 2022, the Australian government announced its intention to extend post-study work rights for

international students. Recently, they released the list of degrees that qualify for these extended rights. The purpose of the extended post-study work rights is to cater to workforce shortages in Australia by allowing international students graduating with relevant degrees to stay and work in the country.



The extension applies to the Temporary Graduate Work visa (subclass 485) and increases the 'stay and work' period for eligible graduates of specific qualifications. The new durations are as follows:

- 1 Bachelor degree graduates can now stay and work for four years, up from two years previously.
- 2 Master degree graduates can now stay and work for five years, up from three years previously.
- 3 Doctoral graduates can now stay and work for six years, up from four years previously.

These extensions are in addition to the existing one to two years of work rights provided to eligible students who study, live, and work in regional areas. The new extensions will come into effect on 1 July 2023.

To be eligible for this extension, you must meet the eligibility criteria for the Post-Study Work stream of the Temporary Graduate visa (subclass 485) and have a qualification on the list of eligible qualifications (see below). Additionally, one of the following must apply to you:

- You hold a Temporary Graduate visa (Post-Study Work stream) on 1 July 2023.
- You have lodged an application for a Temporary Graduate visa (Post-Study Work stream) by 1 July 2023.
- You lodge an application for a Temporary Graduate visa (Post-Study Work stream) after 1 July 2023.

If your Temporary Graduate visa (Post-Study Work stream) expires before 1 July 2023 but you hold an eligible qualification, you can still apply for this extension. However, in this case, you will be granted a two-year Temporary Activity Australian Government Endorsed Events (COVID-19 Pandemic Event) visa (subclass 408) instead of a further Temporary Graduate visa (subclass 485).

If you were granted a Temporary Graduate visa (Post-Study Work stream) before 15 December 2021, and the visa took effect on or after 1 February 2020, and you were in Australia for the entire duration of your visa between 1 February 2020 and 15 December 2021, and you hold an eligible qualification, you are also eligible for a two-year Temporary Activity Australian Government Endorsed Events (COVID-19 Pandemic event) visa (subclass 408).
